General Mathematical Formula


Using this method, the local library should divide the library income from local property tax sources or its equivalent (excluding income from State and federal funds) by the local population to determine the cost of service per capita. The library should multiply the per capita figure by the average number of persons per household in the community to obtain the average cost per household on which to base a fee for a non-resident family card. The most recent federal census information available shall be used to determine population and average household size.

Recommended for Fiscal Year 2026 – 2027:

Reciprocal User Fee \$142.00 to begin July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027
